Choice Hotels NEC Player of the Week

Joey Mundweiler, Wagner

Sr., G, 6-2, 190 lbs., Olathe, KS/Olathe East

Needing a win to qualify for the NEC Tournament, Mundweiler rose to the occasion with perhaps the greatest shooting performance in league history in Wagner's 91-60 win over Monmouth on Saturday. The Olathe, KS native established an NCAA single-game season-high, as well as a school and NEC record with 11 three-pointers in the victory en-route to a career-high 39-point performance. The 39 points were the most by a Wagner player since Dean Borges hit for 39 on December 9, 1987. It also represented an NEC single-game season-best and marked the highest output in an NEC game since Tristan Blackwood dropped 40 against Robert Morris on February 22, 2007. Ironically, Mundweiler broke the single-game NEC three-point record of 10 that Blackwood matched in that very game. The Mount's Scott Murphy also hit 10 trifectas in a game back on February 7, 1991. Coupled with an 18-point effort in the Seahawks' 75-66 victory at Quinnipiac on Thursday, Mundweiler averaged 28.5 points and shot 57.1 percent from the field on the week, including a blistering 55.1 percent (16-29) from long range. He leads the NEC with 91 three-pointers and 3.1 per game, and also ranks 11th in 3PPG percentage (.397) and scoring (14.0 ppg). Mundweiler has moved into second place on the NEC's career list with 305 treys. Among active league players, Mundweiler is third in career scoring with 1,259 points. He also sits 19th on Wagner's all-time scoring list. Seeded seventh, Wagner will travel to second seeded Mount St. Mary's in an NEC quarterfinal matchup on Thursday.

Choice Hotels NEC Rookie of the Week

Julian Boyd, Long Island

Fr., F, 6-6, 220 lbs., San Antonio, TX/William H. Taft

Boyd's debut year culminates with his league-leading sixth Choice Hotels NEC Rookie of the Week honor, the most in a season since Saint Francis (PA)'s Darshan Luckey was honored on eight occasions in 2002-03. He averaged 13.5 points and 9.5 rebounds last week in a pair of Long Island road wins that clinched the #4 seed and an NEC Tournament quarterfinal home game against Quinnipiac on Thursday. Boyd tallied 10 points (6-6 FT), eight rebounds and a pair of assists in LIU's 85-67 win at Fairleigh Dickinson on Thursday. Two nights later, he posted his fourth double-double of the year with 17 points and 11 rebounds in just 24 minutes as the Blackbirds downed St. Francis (NY), 66-54, in the annual "Battle of Brooklyn." He did not commit a turnover in 54 minutes of court time on the week. Boyd, who hails from San Antonio, TX, enters the postseason ranked first among NEC freshmen in rebounding (6.3 rpg), and second in scoring (10.3 ppg) and field goal percentage (.508) despite averaging just 22.6 mpg off the bench.

Robert Morris (22-10, 15-3 NEC)



- Top-seeded Robert Morris raced out to a 22-point first half lead and held off a late St. Francis (NY) charge for a 73-60 win in an NEC quarterfinal matchup in Moon Township on Thursday.
- NEC Player of the Year **Jeremy Chappell** (Cincinnati, OH/Northwest) led the way for the Colonials with 19 points, five rebounds and six assists, while second team all-NEC performer **Rob Robinson** (Waldorf, MD/Globe Institute of Technology) chipped in with nine points and 13 rebounds.
- Robert Morris has won nine straight games at home and is 13-2 at the Sewall Center on the year.
- The Colonials will take on #5 Quinnipiac in Sunday's semifinals in a game to air live at 2:00 pm on MSG and Fox College Sports, and on delay at 8:30 pm on FSN-Pittsburgh.
- Robert Morris and Quinnipiac have never met in the postseason. The Colonials swept the Bobcats during the 2008-09 regular season.
- In the two games this season against Quinnipiac, Robinson averaged 18.5 ppg, 9.5 rpg and 4.5 spg.
- The Colonials have now reached the NEC semifinals in three of the last four years.
- Robert Morris claimed its second straight NEC regular-season championship and sixth overall (eight if its 1981-82 and 1982-83 divisional championships are included) with a 15-3 league record.
- In two seasons under Mike Rice, the Colonials are 31-5 (.861) in NEC play, the second-best two year stretch behind Marist's 28-4 (.875) run from 1986-88.
- Robert Morris is 48-18 (.727) overall the last two seasons.
- The Colonials received a vote in the AP Top-25 poll on February 9th and 16th and reached as high as #23 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major poll on February 16th. During this period, RMU won 13 straight NEC games.
- Robert Morris set a new NEC record with 15 straight road wins over league opponents before the two-year streak was snapped with a three-point loss at Monmouth on February 19th.
- Robert Morris has posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1988-89 (21 wins) and 1989-90 (22 wins) and second time in school history.
- The Colonials have won a league-high five NEC titles, all between 1982 and 1992.
- Robert Morris has won the NEC championship in three of its four previous appearances when seeded first (1989, 1990 and 1992). The top-seeded Colonials were knocked by Mount St. Mary's in the 2008 semifinals.
- Robert Morris is 12-6 all-time in NEC Tournament games at home.
- The Colonials are 9-0 against the second through sixth seeds in the NEC Tournament. The team's three conference losses on the year came to #7 Wagner, #8 St. Francis (NY) and Monmouth, which didn't make the field.
- Junior guard **Jimmy Langhurst** (Willard, OH/Willard) is second in the NEC in 3PPG% (.423).
- Senior guard **Jeremy Chappell** (Cincinnati, OH/Northwest) has established a school record with 121 games played and 117 starting assignments. On Thursday, he eclipsed Chipper Harris' (1980-84) program record with 97 double-digit scoring games.
- Chappell (16.7 ppg, second in NEC) is the leading active scorer and ninth in league annals with 1,824 points.
- Chappell is the only player in NEC history with over 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 250 assists, 250 steals and 200 three-pointers. He enters the postseason with 1,824 points, 661 boards, 330 assists, 261 steals and 235 3PPG.
- Chappell ranks in the NEC top-15 in nine individual categories, including first in steals (2.5 spg, 13th in nation).
- The Colonials lead the NEC in 3PPG percentage (.399) and are second in FG percentage (.476).

Quinnipiac (15-15, 10-8 NEC)



- The #5 seeded Bobcats were the only road team to emerge victorious in Thursday's NEC quarterfinals with an 86-78 overtime win at #4 seed Long Island. Quinnipiac swept all three games with LIU on the year.
- Quinnipiac led by 11 points with 2:37 to play, but LIU ended regulation with a 15-4 run, including a three-pointer at the buzzer to send the game into overtime. In the extra session, senior guard **Bryan Geffen** (Queens, NY/St. Francis Prep (Boston U.)) hit a clutch three-pointer with 2:43 to go to give the Bobcats a four-point lead. Quinnipiac scored the remainder of their points from the line.
- Sophomore forward **Justin Rutty** (Newburgh, NY/Newburgh Free Academy), a first team all-NEC selection, had a monster game with 18 points and 16 boards. Junior forward **James Feldeine** (New York, NY/Cardinal Hayes), the winner of the inaugural NEC Most Improved award and a second team all-NEC performer, led all scorers with 22 points.
- The Bobcats last reached the NEC semifinals in 2007.
- Quinnipiac and Robert Morris have never met in the NEC playoffs. The Colonials won both outings against the Bobcats in the regular season.
- The Quinnipiac-Robert Morris game will air live on MSG and Fox College Sports at 2:00 pm.
- Feldeine averaged 21.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 3.5 spg versus the Colonials in two games this season.
- The Bobcats are 5-5 in NEC Tournament competition (3-0 at home, 2-5 on the road), including a run to the 2002 title game after entering the tourney as the #7 seed. That year, Quinnipiac knocked off #2 Wagner and #3 UMBC before falling to top-seeded CCSU, 78-71, in the championship.
- The Bobcats have now finished over .500 in NEC play in each of the last three seasons.
- Quinnipiac has been strong on the boards all year long. The Bobcats lead the NEC and rank 25th nationally in rebound margin at +5.7 per game.
- In league play, the Bobcats ranked first on the circuit in FG% defense at 40.7 percent.
- Feldeine is the NEC scoring leader at 17.0 ppg. He has more than doubled his scoring average from last season when he posted 8.3 ppg.
- Feldeine is averaging 21.7 ppg over his last three outings.
- Rutty is first in the league with 9.7 rpg (21st in the nation) and 12 double-doubles.
- Rutty ranks second in the nation with 4.5 offensive rebounds per game, second only to Pittsburgh All-American candidate DeJuan Blair.
- Rutty is also tenth in the NEC in scoring at 15.0 ppg, and sits second in the conference and 10th nationally in field goal percentage (.608).
- NEC All-Rookie guard **James Johnson** (Brooklyn, NY/Bishop Loughlin) is the league's freshmen leader in three categories with 4.1 apg, 1.6 spg and a 1.53:1 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Geffen has hit 56 three-pointers on the year to pace the Bobcats.

Mount St. Mary's (18-12, 12-6 NEC)



- Defending NEC champion and #2 seed Mount St. Mary's held serve at home on Thursday, ousting #7 Wagner by a 72-62 margin in quarterfinal play.
- Sophomore guard **Jean Cajou** (Fairfax, VA/Paul VI) scored a game-high 21 points against Wagner, including seven points in the last two minutes of the contest. With Mount St. Mary's ahead by two, Cajou nailed a three-pointer to give the Mount a 64-59 leads with 1:35 left on the clock.
- Sophomore forward **Shawn Atupem** (Newport News, VA/Woodside) scored 16 points off the bench, while junior forward **Kelly Beidler** (Virginia Beach, VA/Tallwood) added 15 points and seven boards.
- Mount St. Mary's and Sacred Heart have met just once in NEC Tournament competition, with the Mountaineers going on the road to defeat the Pioneers, 68-55, in the 2008 NEC title game.
- The Mount and Sacred Heart split their two regular season games with each team winning on its own home floor.
- The Mount has won nine straight home games and is 11-2 at Knott Arena this season. It is the longest homecourt win streak by the Mount since winning 16 in a row from 1994-96.
- The Mount has qualified for the NEC semis in each of the last three years following a six-year absence.
- The Mount will attempt to become the first NEC program to repeat as champions since Rider in 1993 and 1994.
- Mount St. Mary's captured its three NEC titles in 1995, 1999 and 2008.
- The Mount owns the distinction of being both the lowest (#6 seed in 1999) and second-lowest (#4 seed in 2008) seeded teams to win the NEC Tournament.
- Mount St. Mary's is 16-10 all-time in NEC Tournament games, including 5-3 under Brown. The Mount's .615 winning percentage in the postseason ranks second among current NEC institutions.
- The Mount's #2 seed is the highest for the program since a #1 seed in 1996. That year, the Mount fell to Rider in the semifinals. In 1995, the Mountaineers won their first NEC title as the #2 seed.
- Mount St. Mary's is 9-4 all-time in NEC quarterfinal games with victories in each of the last three years.
- Mount St. Mary's is 18-12 this season, the third-most wins by a Mount team since moving to NCAA Division I in 1988-89. The record is 21 set by the 1995-96 squad (21-7), while the Mountaineers went 19-15 during last year's NEC Tournament run.
- The Mount is 7-2 all-time at home in the NEC Tournament.
- The Mount's 12-6 conference record tied for the second-most league wins in program history.
- Mount St. Mary's leads the NEC in scoring defense at 63.3 ppg.
- First team all-NEC guard **Jeremy Goode** (Charlotte, NC/Providence Day) stands fourth among active NEC players with 1,254 points. Goode ranks 23rd on the NEC's career assist list with 460.
- Cajou is second on the team in scoring with 13.5 ppg. He leads the NEC and is seventh nationally in FT percentage (.891).
- The Mount is one of just four teams in the nation to start the same lineup in every game this year. The others are Butler, Clemson and North Dakota State.

Sacred Heart (17-13, 12-6 NEC)



- In NEC quarterfinal action on Thursday, #3 seed Sacred Heart defeated in-state rival CCSU for the third time this season with a 76-64 win over the sixth seeded Blue Devils in Fairfield.
- Junior guard **Chauncey Hardy** (Middletown, CT/Xavier), who had missed the previous two games with a wrist injury, scored a game-high 22 points in the victory.
- First team all-NEC forward **Joey Henley** (Kent, WA/Kentridge) recorded a double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds.
- Sacred Heart now gets a long-awaited rematch with Mount St. Mary's, which beat the Pioneers in last year's NEC championship tilt, 68-55.
- The Pioneers and Mountaineers split their two regular season meetings with each defending its home court.
- A win will give Sacred Heart its third consecutive NEC title game appearance. The Pioneers are 5-3 all-time in the tournament.
- Sacred Heart is now 3-2 against CCSU in NEC Tournament play. The Pioneers have faced the Blue Devils in each of their five NEC Tournament appearances.
- The Pioneers have won six straight games by an average margin of 19.3 points.
- Sacred Heart has now posted three straight winning seasons, a first at the Division I level and first time since the 1987-88 (16-13), 1988-89 (22-10) and 1989-90 Division II campaigns (15-14).
- The Pioneers are the NEC's top scoring team, averaging 73.8 ppg. Sacred Heart also paces the league in field goal percentage (.483, 15th nationally) and assists (17.1 apg, 10th in nation).
- Over the last seven games, Sacred Heart is producing 84.5 ppg, while allowing just 67.4 ppg.
- Sophomore forward **Mehmet Sahan** (Istanbul, Turkey/Tilton School) averaged 14.5 ppg and shot 82.3 percent (14-17) from the floor in two games against the Mount this season.
- Since inserting junior guard **Corey Hassan** (Merrimack, NH/Merrimack (Boston U.)) into the starting lineup, the Pioneers are 13-4.
- Last year the Pioneers went 7-3 down the stretch and finished 13-5 in conference play. In 2006-07, Sacred Heart finished 12-6 in the NEC and won five of its last six regular season games.
- Graduate student forward **Joey Henley** (Kent, WA/Kentridge) leads the NEC and is sixth nationally in field goal percentage (.621). He is also sixth in the conference in scoring (15.7 ppg), sixth in rebounding (6.8 rpg) and fourth in blocks (1.3 bpg).
- Henley is up to 1,383 career points and 642 rebounds, both second among active NEC competitors.
- Four Sacred Heart players average in double figures: Henley (15.8 ppg), Hardy (11.5 ppg), Hassan (11.2 ppg) and senior forward **Ryon Howard** (Bronx, NY/Holderness School) (10.6 ppg).
- Bike, now in his 31st year at Sacred Heart, leads all current NEC coaches with 481 career victories.

1. The NEC will employ a campus site playoff format for the fifth year in a row after an eight-year absence that saw the league's annual postseason tournament contested at one campus site (1999), at a municipal arena (2000-01) and at a single campus site for the quarterfinals and semifinals, followed by the highest remaining seed hosting the championship game (1998, 2002-04). The conference had previously employed a high-seed hosting format from 1991-97, though teams were not reseeded after the quarterfinals as the tournament is currently constructed.
2. Seven of the eight teams that qualified for the 2008 NEC Tournament return again this season. The lone absentee is **Monmouth**. The newcomer is **St. Francis (NY)**.
3. **Central Connecticut State** has earned an NEC Tournament berth 11 straight years, the longest current run in the conference.
4. The NEC has not had a back-to-back tournament winner since Rider in 1993 and 1994. The 15-year drought is the second longest in the country behind the Southland Conference, which last had a team win twice in a row back in 1992 and 1993 (Texas Southern).
5. **Sacred Heart** has made it to two straight NEC championship games, but is still looking for its first NEC title. Three other programs fell in back-to-back NEC championship games, and two of them came back to win it all the following season. **Long Island** lost in 1982 and 1983, then beat Robert Morris for the crown in 1984. **Fairleigh Dickinson** suffered setbacks in 1986 and 1987, then downed Monmouth in the 1988 title tilt. Rider was defeated in 1995 and 1996, then came up short against Long Island in the 1997 semifinals.
6. In one of the great NEC rivalries, **Robert Morris** and **Mount St. Mary's** have met in the conference tournament each of the last three seasons and 11 times overall in the last four years. In each of the three years, the team that swept the regular season series went down in the playoffs. In the 2006 NEC quarterfinals, the fifth-seeded Colonials used a late three-pointer from then-freshman **Jeremy Chappell (Cincinnati, OH/Northwest)** to upend the fourth-seeded Mountaineers in Emmitsburg. In 2007, fifth-seeded Mount St. Mary's returned the favor, winning 78-61 against fourth-seeded Robert Morris in quarterfinal action in Moon Township. In last season's semifinals, top-seeded Robert Morris was ousted by the fourth-seeded Mountaineers, 83-65. Mount St. Mary's would go on to capture its third league crown. To illustrate the tight nature of the rivalry, seven of the 11 meetings between the teams over the past four years have been decided by five points or less. Robert Morris swept the Mount this past season, including a 66-63 victory on the final day of the regular season.
7. Dating back to the 2006 season, this will mark the fourth straight year **Sacred Heart** and **CCSU** will face each other in the postseason and fifth time since 2002 (the Blue Devils are 4-1 in the series). The two programs matched up in an identical #3-#6 quarterfinal game last season with the Pioneers coming away with an 84-71 victory. CCSU had eliminated Sacred Heart from the playoffs in all three of the Pioneers previous tournament appearances, highlighted by a 74-70 triumph in the 2007 NEC title game. Sacred Heart swept the season series from CCSU in 2008-09, including a 101-67 win in New Britain on February 19.
8. In 2008, **Mount St. Mary's** became just the second team in NEC annals to claim the league championship after winning on the road in both the semifinals (over Robert Morris) and title contest (over Sacred Heart). **Monmouth** also turned the trick in 2006, beating CCSU in the semis and FDU for the championship. 28. No NEC team has ever won three straight games on the road to win the league championship. Teams that have won NEC title games on the road (not including neutral sites): **Mount St. Mary's** (2008), **Monmouth** (2006), **FDU** (1998), **Mount St. Mary's** (1995), **FDU** (1985) and **Robert Morris** (1983).
9. Top-seed **Robert Morris** has won the NEC championship in three of its four previous appearances when seeded first (1989, 1990 and 1992). Seeded #1 a year ago, the Colonials were knocked by Mount St. Mary's in the semifinals.
10. Quarterfinal opponents **Long Island** and **Quinnipiac** will meet for the first time in the NEC Tournament.
11. **Sacred Heart** and **Wagner** are the NEC's hottest teams entering the NEC Tournament. The Pioneers have won five straight games by an average margin of 20.8 points. The Seahawks have reeled off four straight wins and six-of-seven.
12. **Wagner** was the final NEC team to qualify for the tournament with a 91-60 victory at Monmouth on Saturday. A loss would have ended the season for the Seahawks.
13. On the season, the four teams hosting quarterfinal games - **Robert Morris** (12-2), **Mount St. Mary's** (10-2), **Sacred Heart** (9-4) and **Long Island** (12-2) - are a combined 42-10 (.808) at home. Robert Morris and Mount St. Mary's have both won eight straight at home.
14. Despite the legacy of first round success #1 seeds have enjoyed in the NEC Tournament, **St. Francis (NY)** may have a puncher's chance at stopping top-seeded **Robert Morris**. The Terriers handed the Colonials their only home setback in league play, 87-79, in their conference opener on December 4th. In the second game in Brooklyn, St. Francis (NY) lost a tightly contested 61-54 matchup.
15. The #2 seed in the NEC Tournament - **Mount St. Mary's** - lost to quarterfinal partner and #7 seed **Wagner** earlier this season. The Mount fell, 70-65, on February 19 in Staten Island after beating the Seahawks by a 65-51 count at home on January 31st.
16. Over two seasons, **Robert Morris** won a league record 15 straight road games against NEC opposition, a streak that ended with a 60-57 loss at Monmouth on February 19. The Colonials, however, will play all their playoff games at home.
17. Though seeded one slot lower, #5 **Quinnipiac** swept #4 **Long Island** during the regular season, including a 78-73 victory in Brooklyn on February 21 that snapped an 11-game winning streak for the Blackbirds at the WRAC. The Bobcats are the only NEC team to defeat LIU in Brooklyn in 2008-09.
18. **Wagner** has the distinction of being the only team in the NEC to own victories over both #1 seed Robert Morris and #2 seed Mount St. Mary's this season.
19. Good times in Fairfield. While the **Sacred Heart** men have won five straight and 10-of-12, the Pioneer women have won 18 straight entering the postseason.
20. **Mount St. Mary's** has earned its highest seed (#2) since 1996 when the Mount entered the playoffs as the top seed.
21. Since moving to the eight-team tourney format in 1998 (seven qualified in 2001 only), **Central Connecticut State** has qualified for the NEC Tournament 11 out of 12 times, while **Robert Morris**, **St. Francis (NY)** and **Wagner** are one behind with ten. **Fairleigh Dickinson** and **Monmouth** have made it nine of those years, followed by eight for **Long Island** and **Mount St. Mary's**, six for **Quinnipiac** (first eligible in 2001) and **Saint Francis (PA)**, and five for **Sacred Heart** (first eligible in 2002).
22. **Robert Morris** and **Fairleigh Dickinson** own the most NEC tournament wins at home with 11. Prior to last year's quarterfinal win over Monmouth, the other 10 home victories for the Colonials came between 1982 and 1994. **Long Island** and **Monmouth** are tied for third with nine apiece.

23. **Central Connecticut State** has recorded the second best winning percentage in NEC Tournament history. The Blue Devils are 14-7 (.667) in ten tourney appearances. Likewise, CCSU head coach **Howie Dickenman** has posted an 14-7 (.667) record in NEC postseason play, the highest winning percentage among active league coaches and tied for fourth all-time.
 24. Since the league scrapped a divisional format in 1984, #1 seeds are a perfect 25-0 in their opening game of the NEC Tournament.
 25. In two of the last four years, #8 seeds have nearly pulled off the first-ever upset of a #1 seed in NEC quarterfinal round play. In 2005, **Monmouth's** Marques Alston hit a layup at the buzzer to give the Hawks a 54-53 win over #8 CCSU. In 2006, **Fairleigh Dickinson's** Gordon Klaiber hit a bucket with ten seconds left on the clock as the Knights avoided the upset with a 66-65 triumph over #8 Quinnipiac.
 26. While only five #7 seeds have ousted a #2 seed in the NEC Tournament, four of these upsets have come since 2000. In 2004, **Central Connecticut State** knocked out St. Francis (NY) (81-68) after **Fairleigh Dickinson** defeated Monmouth (63-61) in 2003, **Quinnipiac** topped Wagner (87-78) in 2002 and **Mount St. Mary's** booted Fairleigh Dickinson (73-68) in 2000. Marist also beat Monmouth (75-60) in 1992.
 27. Only three NEC Tournaments - in 1987, 1991 and 1994 - have gone exactly according to seeding.
 28. Conference teams have posted a 71-30 record (70.3 percent) when hosting NEC Tournament games throughout the league's history (current NEC teams only).
 29. Aside from the ten returning Mount St. Mary's players that won the NEC crown last season, the only other player in this year's tournament who has competed on an NEC championship teams is CCSU's **Joe Seymore (Newark, DE/Hodgson)**.
 30. **CCSU** has won three NEC titles, but only when seeded first in the field (2000, 2002 and 2007).
 31. **Monmouth's** rally from a 20-point second half deficit to win the 2001 NEC crown marked the biggest championship game comeback in league history.
 32. **Fairleigh Dickinson** holds the league record for consecutive NEC semifinal appearances with nine in a row from 1983-91. St. Francis (NY) (1999-03) and Rider (1993-97) turned the trick five consecutive years.
 33. CCSU's **Javier Mojica** (2007), Wagner's **Jermaine Hall** (2003), Monmouth's **Rahsaan Johnson** (2001), CCSU's **Rick Mickens** (2000), Long Island's **Charles Jones** (1997), Rider's **Darrick Suber** (1993), Robert Morris' **Myron Walker** (1992), St. Francis (PA)'s **Mike Iuzzolino** (1991), Robert Morris' **Vaughn Luton** (1989) and Long Island's **Carey Scurry** (1984) all were named NEC regular season and tournament Most Valuable Player. Incidentally, three of these players (Jones, Iuzzolino and Scurry) were named to the NEC's 10-man 25th Anniversary team in January, 2006.
 34. The only teams to win back-to-back NEC titles are **Robert Morris**, which did it twice (1982-83 and 1989-90), along with Marist (1986, 1987) and Rider (1993, 1994).
 35. In what will forever be known as "The Shot," Rider's Darrick Suber earned a place in NEC annals and ESPN Championship Week history in 1993. The Broncos and Seahawks battled tooth-and-nail for 39-plus minutes as Suber and Wagner's Bobby Hopson waged their own individual dual. With the Broncos trailing by a point in the game's waning seconds, Suber went coast-to-coast and hit an off-balance leaner just inside the free-throw line as time expired. The victory sent the Broncos Zoo into a frenzy and for a short time, brought the NEC into the forefront of the college basketball world.
 36. The longest win streak in NEC Tournament history is eight, shared by **Robert Morris** (1982-84) and Rider (1993-95).
 37. NEC Championship games have historically been tightly contested affairs. Six games have been decided by exactly one point, including **Monmouth's** 49-48 win over Fairleigh Dickinson in 2006. Twelve have been decided by five points or less and 18 by ten or fewer points.
 38. **Robert Morris** and **Fairleigh Dickinson** have qualified for 25 of the league's 28 postseason tournaments - tied for most in league history - since the inception of the conference in 1982. The Knights missed out on the festivities in 2002 and 2008. Robert Morris didn't qualify in 1991, 2001 and 2003.
 39. The only coaches involved in this year's tournament who have NEC championships under their belts are CCSU's **Howie Dickenman** and the Mount's **Milan Brown**. Dickenman's Blue Devils won the title in 2000, 2002 and 2007, while Brown's Mountaineers were victorious in 2008.
 40. **Mount St. Mary's** (1999) is the lone NEC school to win the conference title without having both a winning overall and conference record prior to entering the tournament.
 41. **Mount St. Mary's** became the lowest seeded team (#6) to win the NEC Tournament back in 1999. In 2008, the Mount became the second lowest seeded team (#4) to win it all.
 42. Monmouth's **Alex Blackwell** (1990) and Rider's **Charles Smith** (1994) are the only two players to win both NEC Rookie of the Year and NEC Tournament MVP in the same season.
 43. **St. Francis (NY)** is the lone NEC charter member - a group that also includes Fairleigh Dickinson, Long Island, Robert Morris, St. Francis (PA) and Wagner - that has yet to win an NEC title. The Terriers have also played the most games in NEC Tournament history (31) without winning a championship.
 44. Fairleigh Dickinson's **Tom Green** and Marist's Dave Magarity are the only head coaches in league history to capture the NEC Tournament in their first season with their clubs. Every coach at this year's event has previous NEC tourney experience.
 45. The largest margin of victory in an NEC Tournament game is 35 points. That came on March 1, 1996 when **Mount St. Mary's** defeated Long Island, 93-58.
 46. **Robert Morris** set a new NEC Tournament record on March 6, 2004, holding St. Francis (PA) to just 43 points in a quarterfinal victory.
 47. **Robert Morris** has won the most NEC Tournament titles with five, but none since 1992. **Fairleigh Dickinson** has won 27 NEC tournament games, four ahead of Robert Morris for the most in conference history.
 48. Monmouth's **Rahsaan Johnson** holds the NEC Tournament single-game scoring mark with 40 points in an 86-70 loss to St. Francis (NY) on March 3, 2000.
 49. **Fairleigh Dickinson's** 18 straight NEC Tournament appearances from 1984-01 is a league record. **CCSU's** 11 straight appearances is the longest current streak in the conference.

50. This year's event marks the 28th NEC Tournament. The first was contested in 1982 entirely at Marist College and was won by Robert Morris.

Seed Trivia

By winning the 1999 NEC Tournament as the #6 seed, Mount St. Mary's became the lowest seeded NEC team to ever win a tournament championship. The Mount also became the first team in NEC history to win the conference crown without having both a winning overall and conference record prior to entering the tournament...In the 25 years since the NEC changed from a two division format, the #1 seed in the tournament has captured the crown 15 times. Teams seeded at #2 have won six tournaments, while two #3 seeds (Monmouth '96 and Monmouth '06), one #4 seed (Mount St. Mary's '08) and one #6 seed (Mount St. Mary's 99) have won the title...While the top seed has won 15 of 25 NEC Tournament Championships under the current format, in three of the last four years and six of the last 11 seasons, a team other than #1 has walked away with the tournament crown.

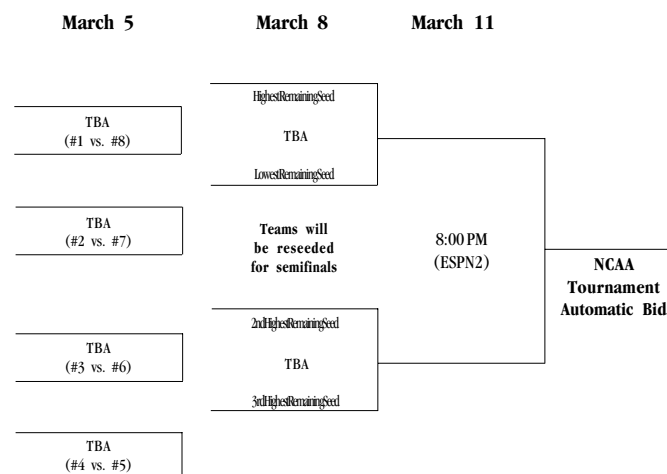
