Media Accreditation Priorities/Criteria

Media

1. National wire services.
2. Media agencies and daily newspapers that cover Northeast Conference teams on a regular basis (priority by circulation).
3. Commercial radio stations and networks which serve as official stations of Northeast Conference members during the season.
4. Media agencies and daily newspapers in the geographic area of the Championship site (priority by circulation).
5. National television networks, radio networks and magazines.
6. Campus-related media of participating institutions (maximum of two credentials for student newspapers and student radio stations providing live broadcasts).
7. Television and radio stations which regularly cover Northeast Conference basketball, but do not provide live coverage of the Northeast Conference Championships.
8. Media agencies outside the geographic region of participating schools or Championship site.

Photography

1. National wire services.
2. Media agencies and daily newspapers that cover Northeast Conference teams on a regular basis (priority by circulation).
3. Media agencies and daily newspapers in the geographic area of the Championship site (priority by circulation).
4. Northeast Conference institution's designated photographer.
5. National magazines planning to publish dated stories on the Northeast Conference Championship.
6. Campus-related media of participating institutions (one credential per outlet).

NEC Tournament Credential Policy

The following conditions are placed on the use of credentials: The working credential is issued for the sole purpose of providing facility access to an accredited agency's employee who has legitimate working function in connection with this Tournament. It is non-transferable. Any unauthorized use of this credential subjects the bearer to immediate dismissal from the Arena and prosecution for criminal trespass.

Any secondary use of any picture, audio description, film/tape or drawing of the game taken or made by the accredited organization or individual to whom this credential has been issued is prohibited without the prior specific written approval by the Northeast Conference.

The NEC reserves all rights to still photographs, film, and videotapes of the NEC Tournament. All rights to such material may be assigned to media representatives for news purposes, but otherwise are to be controlled exclusively by the NEC.
