Quinnipiac (22-8, 15-3 NEC)



- Top-seeded Quinnipiac had their hands full with #8 Monmouth on Thursday, but kept the Hawks at bay the final five minutes of the contest to win, 84-75, and advance to the NEC semis.
- Sophomore guard **James Johnson (Brooklyn, NY/Bishop Loughlin)** scored a game-high 23 points in the win, while NEC Player of the Year **Justin Rutty (Newburgh, NY/Newburgh Free Academy)** recorded his league-leading 15th double-double of the season with 14 points and 13 boards.
- Quinnipiac and #4 Long Island will now meet for the second straight year in the postseason. The Bobcats ousted LIU in the 2009 quarterfinals, 86-78, in overtime. This was the only NEC Tournament meeting between the two programs.
- This year, the Bobcats earned their first-ever NEC regular season title, the #1 seed and home court advantage in the NEC Tournament, along with a guaranteed spot in the Postseason NIT.
- Quinnipiac are taking part in the NEC playoffs for the fifth year in a row. The Bobcats have reached the NEC semifinals in each of Tom Moore's first three years as head coach.
- Moore was named 2009-10 NEC Coach of the Year.
- The Bobcats are 6-6 in NEC Tournament competition (4-0 at home, 2-6 on the road), including a run to the 2002 title game after entering the tourney as the #7 seed. That year, Quinnipiac knocked off #2 Wagner and #3 UMBC before falling to top-seeded CCSU, 78-71, in the championship.
- Quinnipiac has matched the school record with 22 wins. The Bobcats also won 22 in 1979-80 and 1972-73, both under the legendary Burt Kahn.
- The Bobcats are a perfect 13-0 at home this season. Quinnipiac is the first NEC team since Monmouth in 2003-04 to go through the regular season unbeaten at home. The Bobcats are also one of just 11 programs nationwide this season with an unblemished home mark.
- Quinnipiac has played two tourney games at home. The Bobcats also defeated FDU, 78-77, in 2007.
- On February 13, Quinnipiac beat visiting LIU, 80-72, in their only 2009-10 meeting.
- Quinnipiac ranks second in the nation (behind Kentucky) in rebound margin at +9.6 per game. The Bobcats have outrebounded 29-of-30 opponents this season and are on target to break FDU's single-season league record of +9.1 rpg set in 1997-98.
- Ironically, Long Island is the only team to outrebound Quinnipiac (39-38) this season.
- The Bobcats have now finished over .500 in NEC play in each of the last four seasons.
- Junior forward **Justin Rutty (Newburgh, NY/Newburgh Free Academy)** is the NEC's top rebounder (10.9 rpg; 13th nationally) and paces the circuit with 15 double-doubles. He also ranks eighth with 15.0 ppg.
- Junior forward **James Feldeine (New York, NY/Cardinal Hayes)**, a first team All-NEC performer, is the NEC's third-leading scorer at 17.2 ppg.
- Rutty has moved up to 18th on the NEC career rebounding chart with 775.
- Feldeine (1,290 points) and Rutty (1,102) have both eclipsed 1,000 career points.
- Sophomore guard **James Johnson (Brooklyn, NY/Bishop Loughlin)** is averaging 17.0 ppg, 4.9 apg and has shot 45-55 (81.8 percent) from the line over the last eight games.

Long Island (14-16, 11-7 NEC)



- Long Island won its first NEC Tournament since 2005 with a 63-61 win over #5 in quarterfinal round play at the WRAC on Thursday. The Blackbirds fell behind 13-1, then roared back to build a nine-point lead with under six minutes to play. Up by two, neither teams scored after **Kenny Onyechi's (Sugar Land, TX/Kempner)** layup with 1:48 to play. Long Island did have to sweat out a missed Mike Scott shot at the buzzer that would have tied the game.
- Freshman forward **Jamal Olasewere (Silver Spring, MD/Spring Brook)** posted a double-double with 14 points and a career-high 15 rebounds, while sophomore guard **Michael Culpo (Pittsfield, MA/St. Andrew's Prep (RI))** came off the bench to hit five three-pointers and finish with 18 points.
- Long Island is making its third straight NEC Tournament appearance and sixth in Jim Ferry's eight years as head coach. The Blackbirds are 2-5 in those games.
- The Blackbirds will meet Quinnipiac for the second straight year in the NEC Tournament. In 2009, the Blackbirds fell to visiting Quinnipiac in overtime, 86-78.
- Long Island won its two NEC crowns in 1984 and 1997.
- The Blackbirds are 21-20 all-time in tourney play.
- Quinnipiac beat Long Island, 80-72, on February 13th in Hamden. The two teams only met once this season.
- Long Island is 3-4 as the #4 seed (1988, 2001, 2005 and 2009).
- Long Island is 12-7 all-time at home in the NEC Tournament.
- Long Island is now 23-13 in NEC play over the last two years, the best two-year stretch for the program since going 24-12 from 1997-99.
- Senior guard **Jaytornah Wisseh (Brooklyn, N.Y./Banneker Academy)** has dished for five or more assists in each of the last nine games. He leads the NEC with 5.6 apg (22nd nationally) and ranks fourth with 17.1 ppg.
- Wisseh was named to the All-NEC first team for the second year in a row. He was also a second team all-star in 2007-08. Onyechi was tabbed to the NEC All-Rookie team.
- Wisseh is the NEC's second-leading active scorer and 28th all-time with 1,660 points. He is 10th on the league's all-time chart with 531 assists.
- Long Island is one of three teams in the NEC Tournament with a pair of 1,000-point career scorers. Junior guard **Kyle Johnson (Ajax, Ontario/West Hill)** has amassed 1,074 points.
- Freshman forward **Kenny Onyechi (Sugar Land, TX/Kempner)** is the NEC leader with 2.2 blocks per game.
- Olasewere paces all NEC freshman with 6.7 rpg.
- Culpo is the NEC's leading three-point shooter, draining 46.6 percent of his attempts.

Robert Morris (21-11, 15-3 NEC)



- Robert Morris survived a quarterfinal scare from #7 CCSU on Thursday, pulling away late for a 71-63 win.
- NEC Rookie of the Year **Karon Abraham (Paterson, NJ/Harp Academy)** led the Colonials with 18 points, including 4-5 shots from outside the arc. Nursing a one point lead with three minutes to play, Abraham hit back-to-back three pointers to spark a 9-0 run.
- The Colonials had five players in double figures in the win.
- Robert Morris claimed a share of its third straight NEC regular-season championship and seventh overall (nine if 1981-82 and 1982-83 divisional championships are included) with a 15-3 league record.
- The Colonials will attempt to become the first NEC program to repeat as champions since Rider in 1993 and 1994.
- The Colonials have won a league-high six NEC titles, with five of them coming between 1982 and 1992.
- In three seasons under Mike Rice, the Colonials are 46-8 (.852) in NEC play, the best three year stretch in league history in terms of wins and winning percentage.
- Robert Morris has now posted a 103-55 record over the last five years, the most wins over a five-year period in NEC history.
- Robert Morris has posted three straight 20-win seasons for the first time in school history.
- The Colonials are now 71-30 in Rice's three years at the helm of the program.
- The Colonials are 11-3 at home this season.
- Robert Morris is making its seventh straight NEC Tournament appearance. The Colonials have reached the semifinals five times in that span (2004, 2006, 2008-10).
- Robert Morris is 15-6 all-time in NEC Tournament games at home. The 15 home playoff victories are the most in league history.
- Sunday's semifinal game against the Mount will mark the eighth straight tournament home game for Robert Morris. The Colonials are 5-2 in that stretch with both losses coming to Mount St. Mary's.
- Robert Morris and Mount St. Mary's will meet in the NEC Tournament for the fifth straight year. The two teams have split six postseason meetings. The Colonials beat the Mountaineers, 48-46, in the 2009 title game.
- Robert Morris and the Mount split their two regular season meetings with each team defending its home court. This will be the 15th game between the two programs over the last five years.
- Robert Morris is 27-19 (.578) all-time in NEC Tournament play. The 27 wins are tied with FDU for most in league history.
- Abraham leads the Colonials and is the leading freshman scorer in the conference with 13.1 ppg. He leads the NEC in free throw shooting (.867), and ranks third in 3PPG% (.447) and fourth in made three-pointers (2.4/game).
- With 419 points on the year, Abraham has eclipsed former guard Jeremy Chappell's freshman record of 410 points.
- Senior forward **Rob Robinson (Waldorf, MD/Globe Institute of Technology)** was named to the All-NEC second team.
- Senior guard **Mezie Nwigwe (Hyattsville, MD/High Point)**, who has established a new RMU record for games played with 128, was named NEC Defensive Player of the Year.
- RMU's balanced attack has eight players averaging between 5.7 ppg and 13.1 ppg. No player is averaging more than 26.8 minutes per game.

Mount St. Mary's (16-14, 12-6 NEC)



- Preseason NEC favorite Mount St. Mary's utilized a 13-5 run over the final five minutes of the contest to pull away from #6 Saint Francis (PA) and post a 65-50 win.
- Junior guard **Jean Cajou (Fairfax, VA/Paul VI)** and senior guard **Will Holland (Houston, TX/Lamar)** scored 14 points apiece to lead the Mount. Senior forward **Kelly Beidler (Virginia Beach, VA/Tallwood)** also chipped in with 13 points and nine rebounds.
- The NEC's hottest team, the Mount has run off 11 straight wins - the longest streak in the conference this season - following a 2-6 start in league play. The 11-game win streak is the longest for the program since a 15-game streak during the 1995-96 season.
- The Mount is appearing in its fifth straight NEC tourney and sixth in seven years under Milan Brown.
- The Mountaineers are the only team in the history of the NEC to have winning and losing streaks of at least nine in the same season.
- Mount St. Mary's captured its three NEC titles in 1995, 1999 and 2008.
- The Mount owns the distinction of being both the lowest (#6 seed in 1999) and second-lowest (#4 seed in 2008) seeded teams to win the NEC Tournament.
- Mount St. Mary's is 18-11 all-time in NEC Tournament games, including 7-4 under Brown. The Mount's .623 winning percentage in the postseason ranks first among current NEC institutions.
- Mount St. Mary's and Robert Morris are set to lock horns for the fifth straight year in the post-season. The two programs will also play for the 15th time in the last five years.
- The Mount and Robert Morris have split six NEC Tournament games.
- Mount St. Mary's and Robert Morris split their two regular season meetings with each team defending its home court. The Mount won on the final day of the regular season, 63-61.
- Mount St. Mary's is 10-4 all-time in NEC quarterfinal games with victories in each of the last four years.
- The Mount is assured of finishing at least .500 overall record for the third straight year, a feat that had not been accomplished since the three-year span from 1994-97.
- The Mount is 9-2 all-time at home in the NEC Tournament.
- The Mount has posted back-to-back 12-6 NEC marks, which ties for the second-most league wins in program history. The 1995-96 squad went 16-2 and the 1994-95 team also went 12-6.
- Mount St. Mary's leads the NEC in scoring defense (62.6 ppg), field goal percentage defense (.405) and 3PPG% defense (.300). The Mount has held 17 straight teams to under 70 points.
- Senior guard **Jeremy Goode (Charlotte, NC/Providence Day)** has moved into second place on the NEC career assist list with 600. He is also 23rd on the career scoring chart with 1,696 points.
- Goode was named to the All-NEC first team for the second year in a row.
- Beidler has also cracked the 1,000 point mark (1,032 points) with Cajou approaching the milestone (960 points).
- Junior forward **Shawn Atupem (Newport News, VA/Woodside)** has hit 19 of his last 22 shots from the field (.864).
- Senior guard **Will Holland (Houston, TX/Lamar)** has hit 30 of his last 50 shots from three-point range (.600). In doing so, he now ranks second in the NEC in 3PPG% at 45.7 percent.

1. The Northeast Conference will employ a campus site playoff format for the sixth year in a row after an eight-year absence that saw the league's annual postseason tournament contested at one campus site (1999), at a municipal arena (2000-01) and at a single campus site for the quarterfinals and semifinals, followed by the highest remaining seed hosting the championship game (1998, 2002-04). The conference had previously employed a high-seed hosting format from 1991-97, though teams were not reseeded after the quarterfinals as the tournament is currently constructed.
2. Only five of the eight teams that qualified for the 2009 NEC Tournament return again this season. The absentees are **Sacred Heart**, **St. Francis (NY)** and **Wagner**. The newcomers are **Fairleigh Dickinson**, **Monmouth** and **Saint Francis (PA)**.
3. **Central Connecticut State** has earned an NEC Tournament berth 12 straight years, the longest current run in the conference. **Fairleigh Dickinson** holds the league record with 18 straight appearances from 1984-01.
4. The NEC has not had a back-to-back tournament winner since Rider in 1993 and 1994. The 16-year drought is the second longest in the country behind the Southland Conference, which last had a team win twice in a row back in 1992 and 1993 (Louisiana-Monroe).
5. **Saint Francis (PA)** will make its first NEC Tournament appearance since 2005. Looking to end a 15-year drought, the Red Flash are shooting for their first playoff victory since stopping St. Francis (NY), 95-76, in a 1995 opening round game. Saint Francis (PA) last reached the NEC semifinals in 1991, the same year the Red Flash won their lone NEC crown with a 97-82 win over Fairleigh Dickinson.
6. In what has developed into one of the great NEC rivalries, **Robert Morris** and **Mount St. Mary's** have met in the conference tournament in each of the last four seasons and 14 times over since the start of the 2005 season, and could once again be on a collision course with a potential semifinal matchup looming in Moon Township. The two teams split their season series in 2009-10, with the Colonials recording a 63-57 victory back on December 3rd in both team's NEC openers, before the Mount returned the favor on the final day of the regular season with a 63-61 win. Robert Morris leads the series over the past four-plus years by a 9-5 margin. To illustrate the tight nature of the rivalry, nine of the 14 meetings between the teams since the 2005-06 season have been decided by five points or less and the average margin of victory is just 5.9 points. There have been some memorable postseason games between the two programs, highlighted by Robert Morris rallying to defeat the Mount on a last second **Dallas Green** shot, 48-46, in the 2009 title game. The previous three years, the team that swept the regular season series went down in the playoffs. In the 2006 NEC quarterfinals, the fifth-seeded Colonials used a late three-pointer from then-freshman Jeremy Chappell to upend fourth-seeded Mount in Emmitsburg. In 2007, fifth-seeded Mount St. Mary's returned the favor, winning 78-61 against fourth-seeded RMU in quarterfinal action in Moon Township. In the 2008 semifinals, top-seeded RMU was ousted by the fourth-seeded Mountaineers, 83-65. The Mount would go on to capture its third league crown.
7. **Quinnipiac**, which won a share of its first-ever NEC regular season championship and a school Division I record 21 games, will take on **Monmouth** for the first time in NEC Tournament play. The Bobcats finish tied for first with **Robert Morris**, but earned the top seed and automatic berth to the Postseason NIT by beating the Colonials, 87-79, in their lone meeting on February 20.
8. **Mount St. Mary's** is the league's hottest team entering the NEC Tournament. The Mount has won 10 straight games - the longest streak in the conference this season - by an average margin of 16.9 points.
9. **Central Connecticut State** was the final NEC team to qualify for the tournament with a 68-56 victory over St. Francis (NY) in what amounted to a play-in game on Saturday. A win would have sent the Terriers to the tourney and ended the season for the Blue Devils.
10. **Quinnipiac** posted a perfect 12-0 home record during the regular season. The last NEC team to run through the regular season without losing at home was Monmouth, which finished the 2003-04 regular season 12-0, then defeated CCSU in the NEC title game in West Long Branch.
11. On the season, the four teams hosting quarterfinal games - **Quinnipiac** (12-0), **Robert Morris** (10-3), **Mount St. Mary's** (9-3) and **Long Island** (9-3) - are a combined 40-9 (.816) at home.
12. Since the league scrapped a divisional format in 1984, #1 seeds are a perfect 26-0 in their opening game of the NEC Tournament.
13. Despite the legacy of first round success #1 seeds have enjoyed in the NEC Tournament, **Monmouth** may have a puncher's chance at stopping top-seeded **Quinnipiac**. The Hawks handed the Bobcats the first of their three conference setbacks this season with a 72-60 victory in West Long Branch on January 2nd.
14. The #3 seed in the NEC Tournament - **Mount St. Mary's** - lost to quarterfinal partner and #6 seed **Saint Francis (PA)** earlier this season. The Mount fell, 73-66, in Loretto on December 5th. Mount St. Mary's did come back to knock off the Red Flash, 67-51, on February 25th.
15. **Robert Morris** is the only NEC team with a winning mark on the road at 9-7. Should they advance, the Colonials will play at least the first two rounds at home. Robert Morris could play away from home in the title game at top seeded **Quinnipiac**. The two teams met just once this season with the Bobcats scoring an 87-79 victory in Moon Township on February 20th.
16. **Long Island**, seeded fourth, beat fifth seed and quarterfinal opponent **Fairleigh Dickinson**, 68-62, in their only meeting this season back on February 18th in Brooklyn.
17. **Mount St. Mary's** has the distinction of being the only team in the NEC to own victories over top seeds Quinnipiac and Robert Morris this season.
18. Good times in Moon Township. While the **Robert Morris** men tied for the top spot with a 15-3 record, the Colonial women earned the top seed in the women's tourney with a 17-1 mark. This marked the second time in three years that both the RMU men and women both won conference regular season titles. Mount St. Mary's (1995-96) is the only other school that has won both in the same year.
19. **Monmouth** needed eight wins to qualify for the final NEC Tournament spot. The last time a team needed at least eight wins to secure a playoff spot was back in 2005 when CCSU entered the postseason with an 8-10 mark.
20. Since moving to the eight-team tourney format in 1998 (seven qualified in 2001 only), **Central Connecticut State** has qualified for the NEC Tournament 12 out of 13 times, with **Robert Morris** one behind with 11. **Fairleigh Dickinson**, **Monmouth**, **St. Francis (NY)** and **Wagner** have made it ten of those years, followed by nine for **Long Island** and **Mount St. Mary's**, seven for **Quinnipiac** (first eligible in 2001) and **Saint Francis (PA)**, and five for **Sacred Heart** (first eligible in 2002).
21. **Robert Morris** owns the most NEC tournament wins at home with 14. Prior to the four wins in Moon Township the last two years, the other 10 home victories for the Colonials came between 1982 and 1994. **Fairleigh Dickinson** is second with 11, followed by **Long Island** and **Monmouth** tied for third with nine apiece.
22. **Central Connecticut State** has recorded the second best winning percentage in NEC Tournament history. The Blue Devils are 14-8 (.636) in 11 tourney appearances. Likewise, CCSU head coach **Howie Dickenman** has posted an 14-8 (.636) record in NEC postseason play, the second-highest winning

percentage among active league coaches and sixth all-time.

23. Within the last five years, two #8 seeds have nearly pulled off the first-ever upset of a #1 seed in NEC quarterfinal round play. In 2005, **Monmouth's** Marques Alston hit a layup at the buzzer to give the Hawks a 54-53 win over #8 CCSU. In 2006, **Fairleigh Dickinson's** Gordon Klaiber hit a bucket with ten seconds left on the clock as the Knights avoided the upset with a 66-65 triumph over #8 Quinnipiac.
24. While only five #7 seeds have ousted a #2 seed in the NEC Tournament, four of these upsets have come since 2000. In 2004, **Central Connecticut State** knocked out St. Francis (NY) (81-68) after **Fairleigh Dickinson** defeated Monmouth (63-61) in 2003. **Quinnipiac** topped Wagner (87-78) in 2002 and **Mount St. Mary's** bootied Fairleigh Dickinson (73-68) in 2000. Marist also beat Monmouth (75-60) in 1992.
25. Only three NEC Tournaments - in 1987, 1991 and 1994 - have gone exactly according to seeding.
26. Conference teams have posted a 77-31 record (71.3 percent) when hosting NEC Tournament games throughout the league's history (current NEC teams only).
27. There are 17 players in this year's tournament who have competed on NEC championship teams. For Mount St. Mary's (2008): **Jeremy Goode, Kelly Beidler, Will Holland, Jean Cajou, Shawn Atupem, Pierre Brown, Tayvon Jackson** and **Kevin Jones**. For Robert Morris (2009): **Rob Robinson, Mezie Nwigwe, Dallas Green, Gary Wallace, Josiah Whitehead, Khalif Foster** and **Jimmy Langhurst**. CCSU's **Joe Seymore** (2007) and Monmouth's **Whitney Coleman** (2006) have also won NEC titles.
28. CCSU has won three NEC titles, but only when seeded first in the field (2000, 2002 and 2007).
29. **Monmouth's** rally from a 20-point second half deficit to win the 2001 NEC crown marked the biggest championship game comeback in league history.
30. **Fairleigh Dickinson** holds the league record for consecutive NEC semifinal appearances with nine in a row from 1983-91. St. Francis (NY) (1999-03) and Rider (1993-97) turned the trick five consecutive years.
31. Robert Morris' **Jeremy Chappell** (2009), CCSU's **Javier Mojica** (2007), Wagner's **Jermaine Hall** (2003), Monmouth's **Rahsaan Johnson** (2001), CCSU's **Rick Mickens** (2000), Long Island's **Charles Jones** (1997), Rider's **Darrick Suber** (1993), Robert Morris' **Myron Walker** (1992), St. Francis (PA)'s **Mike Iuzzolino** (1991), Robert Morris' **Vaughn Luton** (1989) and Long Island's **Carey Scurry** (1984) all were named NEC regular season and tournament Most Valuable Player. Incidentally, three of these players (Jones, Iuzzolino and Scurry) were named to the NEC's 10-man 25th Anniversary team in January, 2006.
32. The only teams to win back-to-back NEC titles are **Robert Morris**, which did it twice (1982-83 and 1989-90), along with Marist (1986, 1987) and Rider (1993, 1994).
33. In what will forever be known as "The Shot," Rider's Darrick Suber earned a place in NEC annals and ESPN Championship Week history in 1993. The Broncos and Seahawks battled tooth-and-nail for 39-plus minutes as Suber and Wagner's Bobby Hopson waged their own individual dual. With the Broncos trailing by a point in the game's waning seconds, Suber went coast-to-coast and hit an off-balance leaner just inside the free-throw line as time expired. The victory sent the Broncos Zoo into a frenzy and for a short time, brought the NEC into the forefront of the college basketball world. Look for a feature article on "The Shot" in this year's NEC Tournament program.
34. The longest win streak in NEC Tournament history is eight, shared by **Robert Morris** (1982-84) and Rider (1993-95).
35. In 2008, **Mount St. Mary's** became just the second team in NEC annals to claim the league championship after winning on the road in both the semifinals (over Robert Morris) and title contest (over Sacred Heart). **Monmouth** also turned the trick in 2006, beating CCSU in the semis and FDU for the championship. No NEC team has ever won three straight games on the road to win the league championship. Teams that have won NEC title games on the road (not including neutral sites): **Mount St. Mary's** (2008), **Monmouth** (2006), **FDU** (1998), **Mount St. Mary's** (1995), **FDU** (1985) and **Robert Morris** (1983).
36. NEC Championship games have historically been tightly contested affairs. Six games have been decided by exactly one point, including **Monmouth's** 49-48 win over Fairleigh Dickinson in 2006. A total of 13 have been decided by five points or less and 19 by ten or fewer points.
37. The 2009 NEC title game between **Robert Morris** and **Mount St. Mary's** was the lowest scoring finale in league history. The two teams combined for 94 points as the Colonials won 48-46, on a last second shot by future RMU folk hero **Dallas Green**.
38. **Robert Morris** and **Fairleigh Dickinson** have qualified for 26 of the league's 29 postseason tournaments - tied for most in league history - since the inception of the conference in 1982. The Knights missed out on the festivities in 2002, 2008 and 2009. Robert Morris didn't qualify in 1991, 2001 and 2003.
39. NEC coaches involved in this year's tournament who have conference championships under their belts are CCSU's **Howie Dickenman**, the Mount's **Milan Brown** and RMU's **Mike Rice**. Dickenman's Blue Devils won the title in 2000, 2002 and 2007, while Brown's Mountaineers were victorious in 2008 and Rice's Colonial squad took home the trophy in 2009.
40. **Mount St. Mary's** (1999) is the lone NEC school to win the conference title without having both a winning overall and conference record prior to entering the tournament.
41. **Mount St. Mary's** became the lowest seeded team (#6) to win the NEC Tournament back in 1999. In 2008, the Mount became the second lowest seeded team (#4) to win it all.
42. Monmouth's **Alex Blackwell** (1990) and Rider's **Charles Smith** (1994) are the only two players to win both NEC Rookie of the Year and NEC Tournament MVP in the same season.
43. **St. Francis (NY)** is the lone NEC charter member - a group that also includes Fairleigh Dickinson, Long Island, Robert Morris, St. Francis (PA) and Wagner - that has yet to win an NEC title. The Terriers have also played the most games in NEC Tournament history (32) without winning a championship.
44. Fairleigh Dickinson's Tom Green and Marist's Dave Magarity are the only head coaches in league history to capture the NEC Tournament in their first season with their clubs. Coaches in this year's event without prior NEC tourney experience: FDU's **Greg Vetrone** and Saint Francis (PA)'s **Don Friday**.
45. The largest margin of victory in an NEC Tournament game is 35 points. That came on March 1, 1996 when **Mount St. Mary's** defeated Long Island, 93-58.
46. **Robert Morris** set a new NEC Tournament record on March 6, 2004, holding St. Francis (PA) to just 43 points in a quarterfinal victory.
47. **Robert Morris** has won the most NEC Tournament titles with six. **Fairleigh Dickinson** has won 27 NEC tournament games, one ahead of Robert Morris for the most in conference history.
48. Monmouth's **Rahsaan Johnson** holds the NEC Tournament single-game scoring mark with 40 points in an 86-70 loss to St. Francis (NY) on March 3, 2000.
49. **Fairleigh Dickinson's** 18 straight NEC Tournament appearances from 1984-01 is a league record. CCSU's 12 straight appearances is the longest current streak in the conference.

50. This year's event marks the 29th NEC Tournament. The first was contested in 1982 entirely at Marist College and was won by Robert Morris.

Seed Trivia

By winning the 1999 NEC Tournament as the #6 seed, Mount St. Mary's became the lowest seeded NEC team to ever win a tournament championship. The Mount also became the first team in NEC history to win the conference crown without having both a winning overall and conference record prior to entering the tournament...In the 25 years since the NEC changed from a two division format, the #1 seed in the tournament has captured the crown 16 times. Teams seeded at #2 have won six tournaments, while two #3 seeds (Monmouth '96 and Monmouth '06), one #4 seed (Mount St. Mary's '08) and one #6 seed (Mount St. Mary's '99) have won the title...While the top seed has won 16 of 26 NEC Tournament Championships under the current format, in three of the last five and six of the last 12 seasons, a team other than #1 has walked away with the tournament crown.

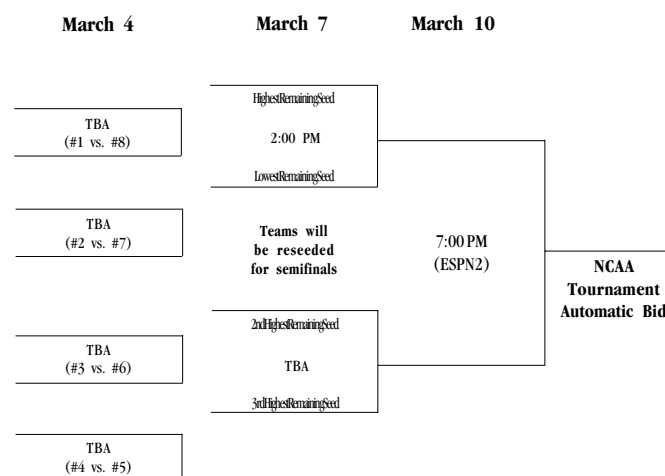
