Fairleigh Dickinson Pulls Away From Tightly Packed Field Heading Into Final Round Wenger, Colligan, Palsson Tie For Top Spot

Daytona Beach, FL - The Fairleigh Dickinson Knights extended their lead through round two, racking up a 32-stroke lead behind the consistent efforts of **Lisa Warrilow (Gnosall, Stafford, UK)**, **Mariana Juarasti (Irapuato, Guanajuato, Mexico/Prepa Tec)** and **Ester Park (Demarset, NJ/Demarset)** who all finished in the top-10. The trio helped their squad card a 312, just two strokes over yesterday's total, for a 622 final. Sacred Heart held on to second place through round two, posting a 317 to wind up with a 654. Robert Morris made up ground from day one, surpassing Saint Francis (PA) to book a two-round total of 657. However, the Red Flash stayed in the mix with a 334 to remain only one stroke behind the Pioneers at 658. Wagner, who shaved an impressive 11 strokes from its round one outing with a 325, kept within striking distance of the top-4, booking a 659 for both days. Claiming the sixth and seventh spots were Monmouth (674) and Long Island (681), respectively. Mount St. Mary's (687) finished up eighth, while Central Connecticut State (694) took ninth and St. Francis College (741) notched tenth. Rounding out the field for the second day was Quinnipiac (832).

Leading the pack individually heading into the final round was Robert Morris' **Elizabeth Wenger (Toledo, OH/Whitmer)**, Long Island's **Anna Palsson (Stockholm, Sweden/Ostra Real)** and Saint Francis' (PA) **Ann Colligan (Kittanning, PA/Kittanning)**. The trio fired a two-round total of 150, while Wenger tallied the lowest score of the day. The junior was the only golfer of the tournament so far to dip below par, climbing from 11th place after round one with a one-under 71 for round two. Palsson and Colligan knocked in rounds of 73 and 75, respectively. Only one stroke off the leaders, FDU's Warrilow turned in a 77 to slip from the top spot to second place. Teammate Juarasti, who also occupied the top spot through the first 18 holes, slid to fifth after carding an 80 on today's attempt for a 154 total. The Knight freshman posted a field-high seven birdies for the second day in a row.

Ellen Huffman (Lima, OH/Lima Central Catholic) made up massive ground to crack the top-10, jumping from 18th to sixth. The Wagner freshman lowered her stroke count from 83 to 75 to finish the day with a 158. In a tie for seventh was Sacred Heart's **Gabriella Riber (Stockholm, Sweden/Danderyds Gymnasium)** and Central's **Anna Ausanio (Hopewell Junction, NY/John Jay)**, both of whom boasted a 159. Pioneer **Brianna Carnahan (Port Jefferson, NY/Earl J. Vandermuelln)** stands in ninth with a 160, while FDU's Park and Saint Francis' (PA) **Caryn Doege (Monroeville, PA/Gateway)** stake each claimed a share of tenth with a 161.

The 2011 NEC Women's Golf Championship will resume play tomorrow, Sunday, April 23th at 8:00 a.m. for the final round.
